## Dark Blue - #1 – (by Cap-Haitien) Bethesda Medical Center Vaudreuil, Haiti



The majority of the services provided by Randolph World Ministries, Inc. reach the people of Haiti through Bethesda Medical Centre. Bethesda is a thriving medical clinic located in a small community called Vaudreuil that is just south of the second largest city in Haiti called Cap-Haitian. Bethesda is owned and operated by Oriental Mission Society (OMS International) a Christian Missionary Organization. Bethesda sees between 100-200 patients per day, five days a week. They are able to operate with a break even budget because no salaries are paid to the missionaries who work in the clinic. Most patients will be seen by a clinician (nurse or doctor), have blood drawn for lab testing, and obtain medication all for approximately the equivalent of one dollar. Bethesda requires that all patients participate in a daily Christian worship service while the clinic staff worship concurrently in a different part of the clinic. Once worship is over, business begins until all patients have been seen, tested and all prescriptions have been filled. The
