Bethesda Medical Center
Vaudreuil, Haiti



The majority of the services provided by Randolph World Ministries, Inc. reach the people of Haiti through Bethesda Medical Centre. Bethesda is a thriving medical clinic located in a small community called Vaudreuil that is just south of the second largest city in Haiti called Cap-Haitien. Bethesda is owned and operated by Oriental Mission Society (OMS International) a Christian Missionary Organization. Bethesda sees between 100-200 patients per day, five days a week. They are able to operate with a break even budget because no salaries are paid to the missionaries who work in the clinic. Most patients will be seen by a clinician (nurse or doctor), have blood drawn for lab testing, and obtain medication all for approximately the equivalent of one dollar. Bethesda requires that all patients participate in a daily Christian worship service while the clinic staff worship concurrently in a different part of the clinic. Once worship is over, business begins until all patients have been seen, tested and all prescriptions have been filled. The

laboratory employs four Haitian trained laboratory professionals and provides approximately 35 tests.
