Gray - #6 – (South of Cap-Haitien) Methodist Clinic Toyar, Haiti



Following our 2006 medical mission trip to Haiti, I received an email from Dr. William Benish, a part-time missionary physician, requesting our services for a small Methodist clinic he has served in Tovar, Haiti. In June of 2007 Randolph World Ministries, Inc. sent a team of 12 to Haiti. A subset of this team composed of Mary Belanus (middle in upper left panel) and Wayne Parks (right in upper left panel) assessed Tovar Clinic which is now a permanent client of Randolph World Ministries, Inc. Since noone spoke English I hired an interpreter named Lucner Pierre (left in upper left panel), who is a long tome friend and native of Haiti. The clinic is one small building (upper right panel) with a small waiting room (lower left panel) and a small lab (lower right panel). The clinic is associated with a Methodist church pastured by a Haitian pastor, Rèv Jean Lesly Dorcèly. There is one LPN Alexandra Sondra, one director Agr. James Donatien, one laboratorian Eglitte R. Fleurmond, a pharmacist, a medical record keeper and a security guard. The Tovar clinic can barely sustain itself but has a lot of potential.
